South Luangwa National Park

Day 01: Lusaka

On arrival at Lusaka Airport you are welcomed by a representative of our local partner agency for your private transfer of about 30 minutes to the Latitude 15° Boutique Hotel. Here you can relax from your flight in the afternoon. There is a little terrace with a garden and swimming pool. You may like to enjoy a leisurely dinner in the restaurant of the hotel (dinner to be paid direct). Latitude 15° Boutique Hotel (Standard Room Original Side)

Day 02: Lusaka – South Luangwa National Park (Southern Part)

In the morning your private transfer is taking you from Latitude 15° Boutique Hotel back to Lusaka Airport, where you board your scheduled flight to Mfuwe at South Luangwa National Park. From Mfuwe Airport it is an about four hours vehicle transfer to Zungulila Camp with some first game viewing en-route inside South Luangwa National Park. Zungulila Bushcamp is located in the remote south of the beautiful South Luangwa National Park. It is overlooking the banks of the Kapamba River with its wide, open plains. This isolated, classic tented safari camp offers a truly, authentic African safari experience to be searched for elsewhere. Built under thatched roofs, each shady tent has its own private veranda with immense views over an impressive variety of wildlife - from the thirsty elephant to the lion and the large herds of buffalo on the grassy surfaces. Simply enjoy this wonderful scenery and a unique and pleasant safari ambiance. Zungulila Bushcamp B,L,D



Day 03 & 04: South Luangwa National Park (Southern Part)

Enjoy 2 full days of authentic safari ambiance at your beautiful camp. Those, who are longing to explore the original Africa as it used to be, are just perfectly right at Zungulila Bushcamp. Expert guides are guiding through the unspoilt wilderness of the park, where large herds of buffaloes and elephants wander through the grassy plains to drink at the springs and along the river. The activities are focused on guided walking, although game drives during morning and afternoon hours are also just available as much. In the evening, there is the possibility for great sundowner experiences at the Kapamba River for example or sitting with a drink around the traditional fireplace. Day 05: South Luangwa National Park (Southern Part) – (Northern Part)

In the morning your transfer takes you from Zungulila Bushcamp to Kaingo Camp. This transfer takes approx. 3 hours with further game viewing en-route. Kaingo Camp is privately owned and run by the Shenton Family, which has a proud history of three generations of wildlife conservation in Southern Africa. The intimate camp offers exceptional game viewing in a beautiful and relaxed atmosphere. Kaingo Camp (Chalet) B,L,D

Day 06 – 08: South Luangwa National Park (Northern Part)

Simply enjoy 3 full days to explore this wilderness with your professional guide. Kaingo Camp offers morning and afternoon game drives, whereby the afternoon game drives extend into an evening drive. A third activity is run at midday each day, usually to visit a special photographic hide, a lagoon or ebony forest. Additionally, walking safaris are offered at Kaingo Camp. The terrain in South Luangwa National Park is ideal for walking due to the constantly changing habitat. A typical walking safari lasts about 3-4 hours, but also shorter walks of roughly 1 hour in shaded areas are possible. For the more adventurous traveller Kaingo Camp is also offering optional sleep-outs. 3x Kaingo Camp (Chalet) B,L,D



Day 09: South Luangwa National Park (Northern Part) – Lusaka

In the morning your road transfer takes you from Kaingo Camp to Mfuwe Airport for your scheduled flight to Lusaka, where your surely impressive Zambia journey comes to an end. B

- Transport in a 4x4 safari vehicle at Zungulila Bushcamp and Kaingo Camp with experienced, English speaking guide during the safari (other guests might also join on the same safari vehicle, usually there is a max. of 6 guests on a vehicle, exclusive use of the safari vehicle causes a supplement fee)
- 2 game activities per day at Zungulila Bushcamp and Kaingo Camp (except on days of arrival/departure, where mostly only 1 or none activity is possible)
- Entrance fees for South Luangwa National Park
- Selected drinks at Zungulila Bushcamp and Kaingo Camp (except champagne and selected spirits)
- Laundry at Zungulila Bushcamp and Kaingo Camp
- Certificate of Guarantee (travel price insurance card) (compulsory)

Not included in costs:

- International flights ex/to Europe
- Visa fees Zambia single entry, currently US\$ 50 per person
- Tips as well as personal expenses
- Any meals not mentioned in the programme
- Drinks, unless advised otherwise
- Any optional activities
- Any travel insurance
