Kwandwe Private Game Reserve – Cape Town

Day 01: Cape Town – Kwandwe Private Game Reserve

Upon arrival in Cape Town, you are met directly at the arrival gate by a charter airline representative for your assistance for your check-in for your onward private charter flight to Kwandwe Game Reserve, which takes about 90 minutes. You stay at Kwandwe Great Fish River Lodge, which is located in the malaria-free and private Kwandwe Game Reserve in the Eastern Cape. Here you can experience unforgettable days on safari and with a little safari luck you might even spot the so-called 'Big 5'. Enjoy the comfort and privacy of your accommodation as well as the beautiful scenery with views of the Great Fish River. Day 02 - 04: Kwandwe Private Game Reserve

Spend 3 full days of relaxation and activities offered at Kwandwe Great Fish River Lodge. You can choose between game drives and game walks, always led and guided by a professional guide of Kwandwe. The game drives take place in open 4x4 safari vehicles and are conducted in the early morning and late afternoon. The private Kwandwe Game Reserve is home to elephant, buffalo, leopard, lion, cheetah, rhino and numerous antelopes as well as other plains game. Fishing is also possible. Optionally you might like to learn more about preparing and cooking an authentic South African 'braai' and favourite dishes with local ingredients. Guests at Kwandwe also have the unique opportunity to participate in volunteering towards the Ubunye Foundation by getting involved in activities and or financial donations. 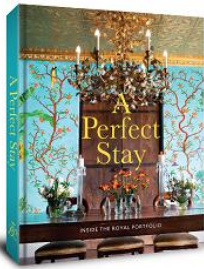
Day 05: Kwandwe Private Game Reserve – Cape Town

Today your private, approx. 90-minutes charter flight takes you directly from the Kwandwe Private Game Reserve back to Cape Town. On arrival at Cape Town Airport a representative of our local agency is waiting for you for your private, approx. 20-minutes road transfer to your hotel. The Silo Hotel is just a walk from the V&A Waterfront and offers both a breathtaking view of Table Mountain and a sensational panoramic view of the Cape metropolis with its harbour and coastline. As the name suggests, the hotel was incorporated into a former grain plant. The architecture and design have been implemented with expertise and sensitivity in such a way that the industrial style with the charm of the selected interior embodies a very own style of the owner Liz Biden. The same building also houses the Zeitz Museum of Contemporary Art Africa, MOCAA for short, on the lower floors. The Silo (Silo Room) B



Day 06 -08: Cape Town / Privately guided tours

Enjoy 3 full days in Cape Town, the 'mother city' of South Africa. We have planned in a privately guided day tour on each day to explore Table Mountain and Cape Town, the Cape of Good Hope and the picturesque Cape Winelands of the Cape Province. *If the weather conditions allow, you start immediately with a cable car ride up Table Mountain (weather permitting). Enjoy fantastic impressions of the entire Cape Peninsula, the sea and the city. During the city tour you visit the Castle of Good Hope as well as the District Six Museum and the colourful residential area Bo-Kaap (Malay Quarter) and Kirstenbosch Gardens.* During your second day tour you explore the Cape Peninsula and the Cape of Good Hope. The funicular takes you up to the highest point at Cape Point within the Nature Reserve, from where you have a sweeping view over the Atlantic. You also visit the penguins at Boulders Beach. *For your third day tour, we have planned in the privately guided tour to the famous winelands of South Africa. You explore the historic university town of Stellenbosch with its numerous Cape Dutch houses and avenues as well as Franschoek with its French influence. On the way you stop at a renowned winery, where you can taste the award-winning South African wines during a wine tasting.* Naturally you can adapt the privately guided tours to your own speed and interest. 3x The Silo (Silo Room) B

- 2 game drives / activities per day at Kwandwe Great Fish River Lodge (except on days of arrival/ departure, where mostly only 1 or none activity is possible)
- 1x privately guided tour of Cape Town and Table Mountain with English speaking guide in Mercedes Vito or similar (including entrance fees for cable car return, Castle of Good Hope, District Six Museum and Kirstenbosch Gardens)
- 1x privately guided tour of Cape of Good Hope with English speaking guide in Mercedes Vito or similar (including entrance fees for funicular one way, Chapman's Peak Drive, Cape Nature Reserve and Boulders Beach)
- 1x privately guided tour to the Winelands with French speaking guide in Mercedes Vito or similar (including entrance fees for 2 Winetastings)
- Entrance fees for Kwandwe Private Game Reserve
- Selected drinks at Kwandwe Great Fish River Lodge (except for champagne & imported spirits)
- Laundry Service at Kwandwe Great Fish River Lodge
