NamibRand Nature Reserve - Sossusvlei – Swakopmund - Skeleton Coast National Park –
Kaokoland - Etosha National Park - Caprivi /Bwabwata National Park

Day 01: Windhoek – NamibRand Nature Reserve

On arrival at Windhoek International Airport, you are welcomed by a representative of the air charter company for your onward private charter flight to the NamibRand Nature Reserve. This flight takes about 80 minutes. From Wolwedans Airstrip your short transfer in an open safari vehicle takes you through enchanting desert scenery to Wolwedans Dune Camp. Wolwedans is in the heart of the NamibRand Nature Reserve. It is a unique and fascinating landscape, which offers a nature experience that is purely magical. Your wishes for the afternoon can be discussed with your guide and hosts. You may like to partake in a first panorama drive with Sundowner drinks at a selected and beautiful viewing spot. Wolwedans Dune Camp L,D



Day 02 & 03: Windhoek – NamibRand Nature Reserve

Enjoy 2 full days by exploring this fascinating and unique area together with your guide. In the mornings and afternoons, you can partake in panorama drives in an open safari vehicle together with your dedicated guide. This is surely an experience you remember, as the landscape simply is so unique and seems to be changing all the time. During your guided activities you get to know the desert and learn about the abilities of the flora and fauna to survive this harsh desert environment. You could also visit old hunting grounds of the Bushmen. Simply enjoy this exceptional landscape, which Wolwedans as one of their major key objectives is protecting with their conservation work. 2x Wolwedans Dune Camp B,L,D

Day 04: NamibRand Nature Reserve – Near Sesriem

Today your private charter flight is taking you to Sossusvlei Airstrip, which takes about 15 minutes. Hoodia Desert Lodge is located on the shores of the Tsauchab River, approx. 22 km from Sesriem, which is the gate to Sossusvlei. A huge platform, which invites you to relax, was built directly over the Tsauchab River. The swimming pool offers refreshment. Enjoy the views from your lodge. You may also like to participate in a short guided walking tour of the lodge. Hoodia Desert Lodge B,L,D



Day 05: Sesriem /Sossusvlei excursion

For today we have planned in a guided excursion to the Sossusvlei for you, which starts very early. The dunes of Sossusvlei have a reputation for being among the highest freestanding dunes in the world. The dunes raise skywards around a shallow depression (the 'vlei') and tower to heights of up to 300 meters. During your excursion you have the chance of walking on the dunes to also get a glimpse of the vlei 'behind'. Usually, your guide takes a picnic basket for a picnic lunch in the shadow of the trees, before you return to the lodge in the afternoon. You may also like to enjoy a beautiful sunset at the lodge and with some luck you may also spot some kudu, oryx or springbok in their natural surroundings. Hoodia Desert Lodge B,L,D

Day 06: Sesriem - Swakopmund

After breakfast, enjoy your private charter flight from Sossusvlei Airstrip to Swakopmund, which takes about 90 minutes. This is a scenic flight and takes you over the Sossusvlei Dunes and along Sandwich Harbour on the Atlantic Ocean to Swakopmund. Your boutique guesthouse is close to the centre of Swakopmund as well as to the beach. In the afternoon you have time to relax and to explore Swakopmund. Cornerstone Guesthouse B

Day 07: Swakopmund /Boat excursion

Enjoy a full day in the coastal town of Swakopmund. We have planned in an approx. 3-hour boat excursion from Walvis Bay for you, where you can watch seals and dolphins playing in the water and enjoy fresh oysters, snacks and sandwiches for a small lunch. Swakopmund, with its Art Nouveau townscape, is situated between the Atlantic Ocean and the dunes, making it Namibia's most popular coastal town, even though many visitors find it too cool to swim, with a maximum temperature of 22°C. The former harbour is now silted up and forms a bay that has become a beach. Palm tree avenues, parks and the refreshingly cool summer climate contribute to the attractiveness of this town. Swakopmund offers nice cafés, an Oceanarium and a local History Museum. Cornerstone Guesthouse B

Day 08: Swakopmund – Skeleton Coast National Park

Today you fly further north to the Skeleton Coast National Park. The private charter flight from Swakopmund to Mowe Bay takes about 100 minutes and enables for impressive aerial views onto the coastline. From Mowe Bay Airstrip it takes about 2 hours by vehicle, until you reach Shipwreck Lodge. This lodge is situated in a private concession of approx. 146.600 ha within the unique Skeleton Coast National Park. The lodge is nestled between dunes with distant views of the Atlantic Ocean, from which the Benguela Current drifts a refreshing breeze. Look forward to seclusion and a special ambience at Shipwreck Lodge, where you stay in one of the 10 rooms, which are shaped like the cabins of shipwrecks. Shipwreck Lodge B,L,D



Day 09: Skeleton Coast National Park

Enjoy your stay at Shipwreck Lodge, where various activities are offered. You might like to participate in a day excursion to Mowe Bay with its seal colony. During this excursion, guests could also see the Suiderkus and Karimona Shipwrecks on the beach as well as the Westies Diamond Mine. Another popular activity is a sundowner drive into the dunes in the afternoon. There would also be the possibility for a day excursion to the Hoarusib River in a four-wheel drive vehicle to show the clay castles, a natural geological formation. During this excursion, if you are lucky, there is also a chance to spot one of the rare and desert-adapted wild animals, such as brown hyenas, desert elephants, desert giraffes or desert lions. These sightings are rare and involve a lot of luck. For nature lovers, lunch can be organised on the beach. This activity is weather depending. The lodge's quad bikes give guests the opportunity to explore the eastern area of the Skeleton Coast National Park, which is inaccessible by normal vehicles. Shipwreck Lodge B,L,D

Day 10: Skeleton Coast National Park - Kaokoland

Today your transfer takes you back to Mowe Bay Airstrip. From there your private charter flight takes you in a north-easterly direction to Orutjanda Airstrip. The flight only takes about 15 minutes and is followed by an approx. 90-minutes vehicle transfer to the camp. Hoanib Valley Camp is situated in the Sesfontein Community Concession area of Kaokoland. Here in the far north-west of Namibia, rugged mountains, sand dunes and vast desert plains dominate the landscape. The camp overlooks the Hoanib River Valley, an oasis that runs lengthwise through one of Africa's most impressive deserts. Hoanib Valley Camp B,L,D



Day 11: Kaokoland

Enjoy your day at Hoanib Valley Camp. Activities on offer include game drives in the desert, which take place in the mornings and afternoons with professional guides. During these drives guests learn more about the wildlife adapted to the desert. Interested guests can also learn about the desert giraffe research project that is conducted in the area. For a cultural experience, guests could spend a morning with a Herero and Himba community to experience a little insight into their fascinating way of life with the harsh climate. More active guests can join a guided nature walk to explore the small beauties of flora and fauna in the desert. Zebras, klipspringers, and kudus move freely through the mountains. You may also see a herd of springbok, oryx antelope or steenbok making their way through the landscape. Hoanib Valley Camp B,L,D

Day 12: Kaokoland - Etosha National Park /Onguma Game Reserve

Your private charter flight continues to Etosha National Park. The takes about 100 minutes. Onguma Tented Camp is awaiting you near the Etosha Von Lindequist Gate on the private Onguma Game Reserve. In the local Herero language, Onguma means, 'the place you don't want to leave'. Later in the afternoon your guide is taking you out on a game drive within the Onguma Game Reserve. With the right luck on your side, you can then also enjoy a nice sundowner out in the wilderness of Onguma Game Reserve. Onguma Tented Camp B,L,D



Day 13 & 14: Etosha National Park /Onguma Game Reserve

Enjoy 2 full days at Onguma Tented Camp filled with a guided morning game drive in the famous Etosha National Park and an afternoon sundowner drive on the private reserve. Etosha National Park covers an area of approx. 22.270 km² and is home to more than 100 species and more than 300 different birds. Enjoy the sights on the waterholes and the fabulous ambiance as well as warm colour plays in the pans. The afternoon drives usually take place within the private game reserve. 2x Onguma Tented Camp B,L,D

Day 15: Etosha National Park /Onguma Game Reserve - Caprivi /Bwabwata National Park

Today your private charter flight takes you further north-east into the Caprivi area. The flight takes about 3 hours. Your lodge is located in the far east of the Bwabwata National Park in the Namibian Caprivi. The lodge's majestic viewing deck overlooks the vast floodplains, which regularly host herds of elephant, buffalo or other animals. Nambwa Tented Lodge B,L,D



Day 16 & 17: Caprivi /Bwabwata National Park

Enjoy 2 full days to explore the Bwabwata National Park together with your guide. Game drives, guided walks as well as excursions by boat and in traditional mokoro are on offer at Nambwa Tented Lodge and would always be accompanied and led by a professional guide. This place is also known for beautiful sunsets. With a bit of safari luck, you could also witness the wildlife walking straight through the area of your lodge. The comfort of your lodge and the tasteful interior create a perfect ambiance to relax and unwind and to enjoy great holidays. 2x Nambwa Tented Lodge B,L,D

Day 18: Caprivi /Bwabwata National Park - Windhoek

After your breakfast with beautiful views into the nature of the Caprivi you are taken back to Immelmann Airstrip, where you board your private charter flight back to Windhoek. This flight takes about 4 hours. You may like to spend the remaining afternoon at the pool of your hotel to relive the varied experiences of your exceptional journey. For dinner, we recommend a table reservation at the renowned restaurant at your hotel (dinner to be paid direct) Heinitzburg (Superior Deluxe) B

Day 19: Windhoek

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at the Hotel Heinitzburg. We planned in guaranteed day room use at Hotel Heinitzburg for you, so you can keep your room until your departure in the afternoon. In the afternoon, your private vehicle transfer takes you from Hotel Heinitzburg to Windhoek International Airport, where your surely impressive Namibia journey ends. - 2 activities per day at Wolwedans Dune Camp, Hoodia Desert Lodge, Shipwreck Lodge, Hoanib Valley Camp, Onguma Tented Camp and Nambwa Tented Lodge (except on days of arrival/ departure, where mostly only 1 or none activity is possible)
- 1x guided excursion to Sossusvlei with picnic lunch en-route during your stay at Hoodia Desert Lodge
- 1x Dolphin & Seal Boat Cruise excursion ex/to Walvis Bay with light lunch snacks on board as well as transfers ex/to Swakopmund
- Entrance fees for National Parks, Game Reserves and concession areas
- Selected drinks at Wolwedans Dune Camp, Hoodia Desert Lodge, Shipwreck Lodge, Hoanib Valley Camp, Onguma Tented Camp and Nambwa Tented Lodge (except for selected wines, champagne and spirits)
- Laundry at Shipwreck Lodge, Hoanib Valley Camp and Nambwa Tented Lodge
- Guaranteed use of dayroom at Hotel Heinitzburg until departure on day of departure
