

Samburu National Reserve - Masai Mara Game Reserve

Day 01: Nairobi

You are met on arrival at Nairobi International Airport by a representative of our local partner agency for your private transfer to Crowne Plaza Nairobi Airport, which takes about 10 minutes. This hotel is located on the premises of Nairobi International Airport, so that you get to realise a rather short transfer to your hotel after your late arrival. Crowne Plaza Nairobi Airport Hotel (Superior Room)

Day 02: Nairobi - Samburu National Reserve

In the morning your private transfer takes you from your hotel to Nairobi Wilson Airport, where your scheduled flight departs to the beautiful Samburu National Reserve. On arrival at Sasaab Airstrip, you are welcomed by your guide of Sasaab Camp. Enjoy your short transfer to the camp during which you can already admire the wonderful scenery of the Samburu landscape with its hills and acacia trees. Designed according to strong Moroccan principles, Sasaab indisputably belongs to Kenya's most stylish safari camps. It is overlooking the river Ewaso Nyiro in the heart of the Samburu land. The villa accommodation with canvas sides and thatched roofs is providing sensational views down the river and beyond. In the afternoon you may like to enjoy one of the guided activities on offer. Day 03 & 04: Samburu Nature Reserve

Enjoy and immerse during your 2 full days in this magical place. Explore this fascinating area together with your professional guide. The choice of activities includes morning and afternoon game drives, night drives, guided game walks along the river, camel riding, star gazing, bird watching as well as cultural visits. Your guides are happy to share their extensive knowledge with you and introduce you to the animals unique to this area, such as the Reticulated Giraffe, Grevy's Zebra or Beira Oryx. A special experience here is a nice breakfast cooked in the wilderness. You may also like to relax during an optional massage treatment at the Spa. Another nice experience is a short, guided walk through the vegetable garden of the camp together with the passionate gardener or one of the chefs. When you see this wonderful garden in this desert landscape you admire the delicious food, that your hosts are proudly serving here even more. You may also like to spend one of the nights in your star bed under the star lidded sky on the roof of your tented villa. 2x Sasaab Camp B,L,D









Day 05: Samburu Nature Reserve - Masai Mara Game Reserve

After breakfast you are taken to the nearby Sasaab Airstrip. From here, your flight takes about 90 minutes to the Masai Mara. On arrival in the Masai Mara, a representative of Sala's Camp is welcoming you at the airstrip. The Masai Mara Game Reserve is renowned worldwide for its superb wildlife and endless plains. Sala's Camp is located in the south-eastern part of the Masai Mara Game Reserve on the banks of the Sand River. The Masai Mara Game Reserve, which covers approximately 1.510 km², is the best known and most visited game reserve in Kenya. Sala's Camp is positioned close to the migration routes of the Great Migration in a small forest. In the afternoon, you can enjoy your first game drive in the vastness of the Masai Mara Game Reserve. Day 06 - 08: Masai Mara Game Reserve

Enjoy 3 full days in this fascinating game area. Classic game drives take place daily in the morning and late afternoon. The great animal migration can normally be observed in the Masai Mara with a bit of luck every year from about the beginning of July to the end of October. However, this natural spectacle can by no means be guaranteed, as the animal migrations depend primarily on the rainfall. During the animal migration, over a million wildebeest wander through the vast steppes, followed by zebras and in search of rain. This is a unique experience for any nature lover. Outside this time, the vast plains of the Masai Mara also offer impressive opportunities for game viewing. 3x Sala's Camp B,L,D







Day 09: Masai Mara Game Reserve - Nairobi

In the morning, you board your scheduled flight to Nairobi, which takes about an hour In Nairobi, we have planned a private vehicle with guide for you for the rest of the afternoon, so that you can visit one or two sights and possibly a nice restaurant for lunch (lunch to be paid direct). Your guide would then drive you to a selected restaurant in Nairobi for dinner (dinner is payable directly). Your private vehicle transfer would then take you to Nairobi International Airport, where this surely impressive Kenya trip comes to an end. Alternatively, you may like to extend on the coast. B

Due to the annual rain season Sasaab Camp is closed 16.11.2024 - 30.11.2024 and Sala's Camp is closed 15.04.2024 - 31.05.2024.

Rates are based on a minimum of 2 guests. All outdoor activities are weather dependent.

Included in costs (as per itinerary):

- All transfers, accommodation, meals as per programme
- All domestic flights on a scheduled basis Nairobi Wilson Airport Samburu Masai Mara Nairobi Wilson Airport (based on extended luggage restriction of 25 kg per person including hand luggage)
- Transport in a 4x4 safari vehicle at Sasaab Camp and Sala's Camp with professional, English speaking guide during the safari (other guests might also join on the same safari vehicle, usually there is a max. of 6 guests on a vehicle, exclusive use of the safari vehicle causes a supplement fee) respectively at Ol Donyo Lodge and Cottars' 1920 Camp
- 2 game drives \prime activities per day at Sasaab Camp and Sala's Camp
- (except on days of arrival/departure, where mostly only 1 or no activity is possible) respectively at Ol Donyo Lodge and Cottars' 1920 Camp
- Entrance fees for National Parks, Game Reserves and concession areas
- Selected drinks at Sasaab Camp and Sala's Camp (except for champagne and imported spirits) respectively at Ol Donyo Lodge and Cottars' 1920 Camp
- Laundry at Sasaab Camp and Sala's Camp respectively at Ol Donyo Lodge and Cottars' 1920 Camp
- Flying Doctor Services for your entire Kenya arrangement

Not included in costs:

- International flights ex/to Europe
- Visa fees Kenya respectively since 08.01.2024 fees for an Electronic Travel Authorisation (eTA) for single entry into Kenya, currently US\$ 35 per person (eTA is replacing the former visa fee regulation) (eTA strictly to be organised prior to travelling)
- Any meals not mentioned in the programme
- Drinks, unless advised otherwise
- Tips as well as personal expenses
- Any optional activities
- Any travel insurance
