Victoria Falls - Hwange National Park – Matusadona National Park

Day 01: Victoria Falls

On arrival in Victoria Falls, you are being met by a representative of our local partner agency for your private road transfer to your hotel. Make the most of the remaining afternoon to settle in and enjoy the idyllic setting in the garden, overlooking the mighty Zambezi River. The hotel is situated amongst towering native trees, about 4 km from Victoria Falls. On clear days, you can hear the roar and see the spray from the mighty wall of water. The hotel's restaurant serves optional lunch and dinner, so you would not need to leave your accommodation in the evening. The Palm River Hotel (Deluxe Room)



Day 02: Victoria Falls

For the morning, we have organised a privately guided tour of the Victoria Falls, which takes about 2 hours. Victoria Falls is one of the seven natural wonders of the world and a truly spectacular sight. On your privately guided tour of the Zimbabwean side of the Falls you have the chance to experience its grandeur as your guide explains how this 150-million-year-old phenomenon was created. Start at Livingstone's Statue and Devil's Cataract and proceed through the rain forest to Danger Point. The walk is about 3 km and there are various viewpoints along the way. After your privately guided walk, we have planned in a 12-minutes scenic flight in a helicopter over Victoria Falls, where you can admire the same from a bird's eye perspective. You can then enjoy lunch in a selected restaurant (drinks to be paid direct) before your private transfer is taking you back to your hotel. Enjoy the remaining day in the comfort of your hotel or partaking in optional activities. The Palm River Hotel (Deluxe Room) B

Day 03: Victoria Falls – Hwange National Park

In the morning your private transfer is taking you back to Victoria Falls Airport, where you board your seat-in charter flight to Hwange National Park. This flight takes approx. 45 minutes. On arrival at your airstrip, you are welcomed by a representative of Verney's Camp and transferred to the camp. You may already be able to enjoy some first game viewing en-route. Verney's Camp is based in a private concession in the heart of Hwange National Park. The camp is located at Verney's Pan, which is situated on a large open floodplain surrounded by teak forest typical of Hwange National Park. The waterhole at Verney's Camp plays host to numerous animals and is a playground for the famous elephant herds of Hwange. Enjoy the remaining afternoon to relax or for a first activity offered by the camp. Verney's Camp B,L,D



Day 04 & 05: Hwange National Park

You spend 2 full days to explore the wildlife of Hwange National Park during your activities in the mornings and afternoons. Professionally guided game drives as well as game walks are on offer at the camp. Those are led by professional guides, who love to share their knowledge as well as their love for the wilderness. During the late afternoon game drives, which may reach into the evenings, guests are also introduced to the nocturnal animals and with some luck, you may spot hares, a bushbaby or even a leopard. During Siesta, the swimming pool offers a pleasant way to cool off, or you can cozy up on the terrace with a good book and enjoy the view of the waterhole, which is regularly visited by wild animals. In the dry season, it is absolutely fascinating to watch the elephant families coming to drink. 2x Verney's Camp B,L,D



Day 06: Hwange National Park – Matusadona National Park

This morning you leave Hwange National Park for your seat-in charter flight to Fothergill Island, which takes about 90 minutes. Fothergill Island Camp is located within Matusadona National Park on the shore of Lake Kariba in the northern part of Zimbabwe. Lake Kariba is the largest man-made lake in the world. It is about 300 km downstream from Victoria Falls and is fed by the mighty Zambezi River. Upon arrival at Fothergill Island Camp, you have time to settle in and could already participate in a first activity later in the afternoon. Enjoy a completely different scenery on the lake. You may be in for some fishing with the 'catch and release' method after which you may be lucky enough to enjoy a stunning sunset over Lake Kariba. Fothergill Island Camp B,L,D



Day 07 & 08: Matusadona National Park

Enjoy 2 full days at Fothergill Island Camp, which offers a unique water and land-based safari experience. From boat cruises, fishing, game drives and walking safaris, each activity is led by a professional guide. Beautiful sundowners can be arranged on the coastline of the lake. The sceneries range from a dry, desert landscape to lush wilderness in the gorges of the lake with mountains and forests. The guides are on hand and happily share their wealth of wildlife knowledge with the guests. Guests have the chance to watch elephants on the shore or even swimming. There are also buffalo, lion, zebra, various antelope species and plenty of birds. 2x Fothergill Island Camp B,L,D



Day 09: Matusadona National Park – Harare

After breakfast it is time to bid farewell to this surely impressive Zimbabwe journey. You are taken to the airstrip, where you board your seat-in charter flight to Harare. This takes about an hour. From here you connect to your international flight home. B

Included in the costs (as per itinerary):

- All transfers, accommodation and meals as per programme
- Domestic flights Victoria Falls - Hwange – Matusadona – Harare on a seat-in charter flight basis as per programme (based on a luggage restriction of 20 kg per person including hand luggage)
- Transport in a 4x4 safari vehicle at Verney's Camp and Fothergill Island Camp with experienced, English speaking guide during the safari (other guests might also join on the same safari vehicle, usually there is a max. of 6 guests on a vehicle, exclusive use of the safari vehicle causes a supplement fee)
- 2 game activities per day at Verney's Camp and Fothergill Island Camp (except on days of arrival and departure, where mostly only one or none activity is possible, depending on the schedule of the day)
- Privately guided tour of Victoria Falls including National Park Fees, a 12-minutes scenic flight over Victoria Falls in a helicopter, lunch in a selected restaurant as well as private transfers from your hotel and back
- Entrance fees for National Parks and Conservation Areas
- Selected drinks at Verney's Camp and Fothergill Island Camp (except for champagne and imported spirits)
- Laundry at Verney's Camp and Fothergill Island Camp

Not included in the costs:

- Scheduled long haul flights ex/to Europe
- Visa fees Zimbabwe single entry, currently US\$ 30 per person (can only be obtained at point of entry)
- Any tips as well as personal expenses
- Any meals not mentioned in the programme.
- Drinks, unless advised otherwise
- Any optional services and any travel insurances
